Dear Campers and Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to a nighttime camp program at Camp Four Echoes. We're excited that you'll be joining us at camp this summer!

A typical day/evening/night at camp for your program may look like this:

12:00 noon Wake up. Make and eat "breakfast"
1:00p Camp "Kapers" (duties that everyone performs daily to help keep camp clean and tidy)
1:30p Crafts in the Program Shed with the Arts/Crafts Specialist
3:00p Swimming
4:00p Have a snack and hike to Echo Point for nature activities
5:45p All-Camp Flag Ceremony
6:00p Dinner in the Dining Hall
7:00p Canoe to the marsh
8:30p Meet with other nighttime program to play games and eat s'mores
10:00p Dinner
11:00p Go to the Trading Post (Camp Store)
12:00 midnight Have a snack and hike up to T-Bone hill for stargazing
1:15a Get ready for bed (lights out by 2 am)

Because you will participate in a nighttime unit, here are a few things you should consider bringing to camp: (note: please make sure everything is labeled with your name!)

- Extra flashlight and extra batteries. Headlamps are nice because they are hands-free!
- Clothes you can layer. The weather may be warm during the day, but cool at night. Be ready for both.
- Feel free to bring anything that glows-in-the-dark!
- (For all campers) Make sure you bring a plain white t-shirt, pillowcase or anything else you would like to tie-dye or decorate. That's a very popular activity at camp!

Parents/Guardians, please know that your camper probably will not be getting as much sleep as usual. We will do our best to help the campers get back onto a normal schedule by the end of camp, but you can still expect your camper to be tired when you pick her up. Think "Day After Slumber Party" and you'll be ready to welcome your camper home!
