**Summer Fun for Girls at Camp Four Echoes at Lake Coeur d'Alene

Camp Four Echoes at Lake Coeur d'Alene is the ideal summer adventure camp for girls in grades 1-12. Online registration for summer 2014 camp sessions at Camp Four Echoes, a Girl Scout owned and operated waterfront camp, is open now!

Summer camp sessions begin June 25 and run through August 7, 2014. There are more than 32 sessions to choose from ranging in length from 4-15 days. Each session is geared toward a specific age and interest level. Prices range from \$165 (four days) to \$550 (15 days). You don't have to be a Girl Scout to attend Camp Four Echoes—you just have to be a girl.

Fun and creative themed weeks include *Mad Science, Night Owls, Just Chill, Art to Wear, Jump in the Lake, Imaginarium, Dip, Dip & Swing, Everything H2O, Spotlights On, Teen J.A.M., Nocturnals* and much more. There are special sessions for girls interested in more advanced skills such as sailing, paddle boarding, windsurfing, canoeing and more. Our camp gives girls time to relax, do things they don't get to do the rest of the year and make new friends that will last a lifetime. Camp Four Echoes is an extraordinary 212 acre waterfront camp on beautiful Lake Coeur d'Alene, where girls can explore everything from hiking, sailing, a certified ropes course and archery to windsurfing, stargazing, art, geography, outdoor cooking, games and all the things that a lake has to offer, including a beach party!”

More than 34,000 girls and women have spent their summers at Camp Four Echoes at Lake Coeur d'Alene since the camp opened in 1938. This summer marks the 76th anniversary for girls and women of all ages who have cherished memories of summers spent on the shores Lake Coeur d'Alene attending Camp Four Echoes.

Camp Four Echoes is owned and operated by Girl Scouts Eastern Washington and Northern Idaho. It operates as a summer resident camp for all girls in grades 1-12 each year from mid-June through mid-August and hosts other troop, volunteer and council related activities year round. Camp Four Echoes is also a location for volunteer training for adult leaders, council fund raising events, such as Women's Weekend, and is available for community and outside groups to rent

for outings, youth group events and special events year round when not in use for council sponsored activities. The camp features six themed camp sites, a modern lodge (built in 2011), hiking, geocaching, water activities, archery range, certified ropes course, a mile of waterfront and 212 wooded acres to explore daily.

Family Fun Day at Camp Four Echoes will be held Saturday, June 22 from 1-4 p.m. at the camp. This open house format gives parents and girls the opportunity to tour the camp, meet the 2014 camp staff, explore the themed campsites (tee pees, chalets, tree houses, gazebos and traditional cabins) and enjoy the afternoon at Lake Coeur d'Alene.
